- Take daily gravities
- Fill casks
- Harvest and pitch yeast
- Manage cask ales program
- Maintain wash down equipment
- Clean out kegs and casks
- · Fill kegs and casks
- Clean tap lines and jockey boxes
- Maintain packaging records
- Make local deliveries as needed
- Clean and maintain the keg washing and milling areas
- Load and unload trucks
- Assist with maintenance and overall cleanliness of entire brewery and cellar including tank exteriors and floors
